

MUSIC CLUB OF HOLLYWOOD FLORIDA 2023 SUMMER STUDY GRANTS GENERAL INFORMATION

NOTE: Only students entering high school in the fall or students already in high school, with the exception of past/current grant recipients, will be eligible to receive grants.

1. The scholarship recipient shall be chosen on the basis of merit, musical ability, character, and need following an audition before the scholarship committee.
2. The summer music study program may be the student's choice.
3. The payment of the scholarship shall be only to the music school or private teacher.
4. The Scholarship Committee's decision, based on the judges' input, and other considerations, will be final.
5. The scholarship awards are funded annually by the Music Club of Hollywood Florida. The number and dollar value of the awards will vary from year to year.
6. Scholarship Applicant must be an American citizen. And must be a current resident of greater Broward County or had competed in the National Federation of Music Club under Music Club of Hollywood Florida.
7. Late or incomplete applications are grounds for disqualification.
8. Awarded students are encouraged to schedule a performance at a regularly scheduled Music Club of Hollywood's meeting or special event during the upcoming November – May season.
9. The Music Club of Hollywood Florida reserves the right to use audio and video recordings made under our sponsorship for promotional purposes. We will ask the student permission for use of media that is made public on YouTube on the Music Club of Hollywood's channel, and other video sharing sites such as Facebook and others that are searchable on the internet.
10. The Music Club of Hollywood Florida will not issue checks related to Summer Study Grants after **September 15, 2023**.
